

Behavioral Intervention Implementation Steps- Development of the evidence report

For behavioral counseling topics which previously received an “A” or “B” grade recommendation from the USPSTF when a recommendation was last issued, the Contractor shall complete a table highlighting exemplar behavioral interventions identified in the updated review to assist with providing further implementation details. The Table will be based on a modified version of the TIDieR checklist and a footnote should indicate this and include the following reference: Hoffmann TC, Glasziou PP, Boutron I, et al. Better reporting of interventions: template for intervention description and replication (TIDieR) checklist and guide. *BMJ*. 2014;348:g1687. Please see Attachment A for an example of the table that will be required.

During the data abstraction phase of the systematic evidence review, the EPC will collect information to complete the Behavioral Intervention Implementation table for 2-3 exemplar interventions

Criteria for selection of exemplar interventions:

- a. Good or fair quality study
- b. Intervention had a significant effect
- c. Intervention protocol available publicly without having to pay
- d. Feasible intervention to implement in primary care/referable from primary care

During the interim check-in call with AHRQ that occurs midway through the completion of the systematic evidence review, the Contractor will provide the list of selected exemplars along with an explanation as to why those interventions were selected. This list shall be approved by AHRQ and the USPSTF Topic Leads.

Once the list of exemplar interventions are approved, the EPC will complete the Behavioral Intervention Implementation Table (structure and content as presented in Table A), and include this table in the draft evidence report and presentation of evidence (both to the topic workgroup during topic preparation, and to the entire Task Force at the in-person meeting), as well as the final evidence report.
